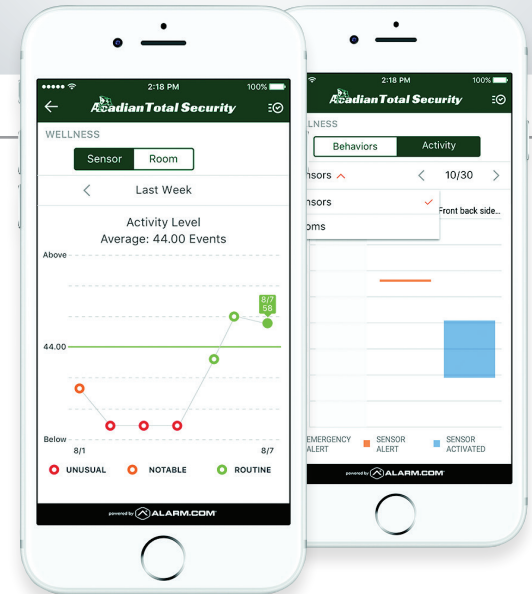
Customizable ConnectedCare

- Medical alert with fall detection
- Unexpected activity

When any of the alert parameters have been met, we will send a message to you and your loved one's mobile device, describing the alert. Another message is sent when an alert situation is no longer present.

Activity Patterns

Up and About/Inactivity
